

## Can We Just Agree On A Few Simple Things

- **Can we agree that these bylaws MUST be changed?**
  - **The bylaws are 52 years old; only 2 chairs in the last 52 years and designed so that they can't be changed and give the chair all of the power with corrupt provisions.**
- **Can we agree that** No reputable organization would allow the Chairman (or woman) of the Board to **appoint new unelected members to the Board of Directors just before holding their own election?** How do you feel as a duly elected committee person that your vote can be cancelled by Pat Poprik simply **appointing** someone to vote for her before the meeting?
- **Can we just agree that the people who actually get elected by the voters should be the ones to decide on endorsements?** The Executive Committee (EC) makes the endorsements, not YOU. **Do you have any idea of what % of the EC is actually elected by the duly elected committee people? It's WAY less than 50%. The EC is a supermajority APPOINTED bureaucracy that decides, not you.**
- **Can we agree that allowing nearly ½ of the votes for the officers to be cast by proxy (in direct conflict with the state bylaws) is guaranteeing corruption and abuse by the chair?** In 2022, 200 of the 420 votes were cast by people who didn't even show up to vote in our most important election and that scores of voters were never elected, but were appointed by Pat in the days before her own election? Who thinks this is moral and ethical, much less legal? Have you ever been involved with an organization that selected its leaders in this fashion?

Folks, until you change the people running the committee, these corrupt bylaws will NEVER be changed and we will continue to be divided and LOSE our races unless it is changed. WE MUST CHANGE LEADERSHIP in order to enact new bylaws that give the committee the ability to oust leaders who aren't performing and have no accountability.
